From 28 November 2025 to 1 January 2026 (extended until 4 January at Place De Brouckère), the capital will once again be transformed into a festive stage of light and creativity. Winter Wonders celebrates Brussels' spirit of solidarity and imagination, showcasing local artisans, artists, traders, and associations while highlighting the city's heritage, culture, and craftsmanship.
